GENERAL RESTRICTIONS:

- Only **TWO** transfer credit courses will be accepted toward the major (B.S. or B.A. degrees). This applies to courses taken in the USA and to study abroad courses. One exception is the London School of Economics (LSE) full-year (Fall and Spring) program, from which up to **FOUR** courses may be counted toward the major.
- ACES enforces prerequisites for many Econ courses.

Notes:

¹Econ 55D replaced Econ 2D/52D beginning Fall 2002; Econ 105D/205D replaced Econ 149/249 beginning Spring 2003; Econ 110D/210D replaced Econ 154/254 beginning Fall 2003. Students who matriculated before Fall 2002 may use former courses.

²Courses taken to fulfill QR requirements may not be used to satisfy any other prerequisites or requirements. Similarly, MATH 135 or MATH 136 can satisfy either the STAT or QR requirements, but not *both*.

³Students matriculating after Fall 2004 may **not** use CPS 1 to satisfy the QR requirement.
